3. Rules:

The following rules and prescriptions apply during the regatta:

- The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 published by ISAF (RRS); - Prescriptions of Hungarian Yachting Association for 2009 (General Sailing Instructions – GSI, Race Regulations, Advertising Regulations);

- Class Rules of participating classes;
- This Notice of Race.

4. Entry

4.1. Pre-entry requirement: competitors are kindly asked to indicate their intention to participate the regatta not later than 1. September 2009. 17.00 hrs. The regatta will not be held for classes in which less than 6 pre-entries are received.

4.2. Place of entry: Balatonfüredi Yacht Club, Clubhouse 1st floor, Race Office

4.3. Time of entry:

For Asso99 and Melges24 classes:

4. September 2009. 7.30-8.30 hrs;

For Nautic, 8m OD, Elliot770, Scholtz22, Sudár Regatta, Dragon and J-24 classes:

- 4. September 2009. 18.00-20.00 hrs and
- 5. September 2009. 7.30-8.30 hrs.

4.4. Entry fee:

For Asso99 and Melges24 classes: 5500 HUF (20 Eur) / person;

For other classes: 4800 HUF (18 Eur) / person. Competitors born on or after 1. January 1991. pay half of the entry fee.

5. Notices to competitors, signals made ashore

5.1. The competitors get information from the Race Committee

through written notices posted on the official notice board. The notice board is located at the entrance of BYC. 5.2. Signals made ashore will be displayed on the main flagpole of the port.

6. Programme

6.1. There are 9 races scheduled for Asso99 and Melges24 classes, all the other classes are planned to sail 6 races.

6.2. 4. September 9.55 hrs

Warning signal for the first race for Asso99 and Melges24 classes, further races back-to-back;

5. September 9.55 hrs

Warning signal for the forthcoming race for Asso99 and Melges24 classes and for the first race for the other classes, further races back-to-back

6. September 9.55 hrs

Warning signal for the forthcoming races, further races backto-back.

6.3. No more than 4 races will be sailed on a day.

6.4. Any race for which a warning signal is not given by 14.00 hrs on the last day of the regatta will be abandoned and not re-sailed.

7. Start, start sequence

7.1. Start sequence for the first race each day

Course "A" (only 5-6 September) Nautic 8m OD Elliot770 Scholtz22 Sudár Regatta Dragon Course "B" Asso99 Melges24 J-24 (only 5-6 September)

7.2. In case of a general recall the new warning signal for the recalled class will be given one minute after lowering the first substitute flag, without modifying the start sequence. This changes GSI 10.9.

8. Class flags

Class flags are the same as the class insignia on the mainsail of each class with the exception of Mel-ges24 class for which the class flag will be Code V flag.

9. Course area and course

9.1. Up&Down courses will be set for each race among Balatonfüred – Siófok – Zamárdi – Tihany. The course diagrams in the attachment include the course configuration. The approximate position of the course areas will be displayed on the official notice board.

9.2. Change of the next leg of the course will not be possible; this changes Rule 33.

10. Marks

10.1. All rounding marks will be yellow (Course "A") and red (Course "B") cylindrical inflated plastic buoys.

10.2. The starting and finishing marks will be buoys with coloured flags.

11. Official boats

Mark laying boats and other official boats will display an orange flag.

12. Penalty system

12.1. The penalties described in Rule 44 apply. Completing a One-Turn Penalty instead of a Two-Turns Penalty is allowed in such classes where the class rule permits it. 12.2. After completing an alternative penalty, boats have to fill in the declaration form within the protest time limit in the Race Office.

13. Protests, requests for redress

Prescriptions in connection with protests and requests for redress can be found in GSI 15.

14. Scoring

14.1. The "Low Point System" described in RRS Appendix A Rule A4 will apply.

14.2. When less than 4 races have been completed, no score will be excluded. When at least 4 races have been completed a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

15. Prize giving ceremony, prizes

15.1. The prize giving ceremony will be held after the last race. Exact time and place will be posted on the official notice board.

15.2. The top 3 boats in each class will be awarded.


16. Social programme

17. Liability

The Balatonfüredi Yacht Club and the Organising Committee do not accept liability for loss of life or prop-erty, personal injury or damage caused by or arising out of the regatta and competitors take part in the re-gatta at their own risk. It is the responsibility of each sailor to decide to participate in a race or to continue racing (see Rule 4 – Decision to race).


